(A unit of pronunciation having one vowel sound, with or without surrounding consonants.)

## Phonemes

(The smallest sounds that help us make words. Phonemes are like the building blocks of words!

For example, the word "cat" has three phonemes:

KUH (the "c" sound), AH (the "a" sound), and TUH (the "t" sound).

When we put these phonemes together, we get the word "cat.")

(Morphemes are the smallest parts of a word that have meaning. The word "happily" has two morphemes: "happy" (the feeling) and "-ly" (which means it's an adverb, telling how something is done.)
